Subject: Entry of Complaints against officers in ERP Vigilance Module - reg.

Ref.: CVC OM No. 021-AIS-1(2) dated 16.03.2022

Kindly refer to above mentioned CVC OM vide which Point no. 13 was revised in the Proforma for furnishing details of officers by the Cadre Controlling Authorities while seeking Vigilance Clearance. It has been mentioned that complaint handling mechanism, vide CVC Circular No. 25/12/21 dated 24.12.2021 (F.No. 021/VGL/051), reads as under:

"Central Vigilance Commission deals with complaints in the matters of corruption and irregular acts having vigilance angle."

Further, the Point no. 13 of VC Proforma has been revised as under:

"13. Whether any complaint with vigilance angle is pending against the officer [if so, details to be furnished]"

Para 1.4.9 of Chapter-1 of Vigilance Manual (updated 2021) also stipulates that administrative misconduct would be dealt by the disciplinary authority in an appropriate manner. If lapse is without vigilance angle, the disciplinary authority would be within its rights to initiate appropriate penalty proceedings against erring employees.

In this connection, it is advised that:

- 1. After receiving any complaint, it should be entered in ERP vigilance module without linking any name of the Officer alleged in the said complaint.
- 2. During the investigation, if, prima facie, suspicious role of any official / officer is involved and lapse related to vigilance angle is found / observed, only then the name may be entered / linked with complaint already entered in the ERP vigilance module so that such complaint may reflect in the VC Proforma.
