

Minutes of Meeting: CEC Meet of AIGETOA WBTC

The Central Executive Meet of AIGETOA WBTC was held at CTTC Salt Lake Kolkata on 11th Sept 2010. The meet was a grand success with a participation of over hundred members from all SSA of West Bengal.

The meeting was also graced by Shri Parthojit Shukla Das CS SC/ST Welfare association WBTC, Shri Atanu Mondal CS AIBSNLOA CTD, Shri T Chatterjee CP AIBSNLOA CTD, Shri Deepak Sahu CS AIGETOA CTD and Shri Dinesh Rai All India Spokesperson AIGETOA.

The meeting started with the address of the CP Shri Prashant Jain, he briefed the house on the recent developments, achievements and future objectives of AIGETOA.

Shri Ashok K Acharya in his address elaborated on the circle achievements regarding R-8, Intracircle Transfers and local issues. CS also briefed about the recent New Delhi meet and the developments.

Shri P S Das CS SC/ST Welfare association in his address mentioned the need of the hour for GE unity and requested support for the welfare of community candidates in BSNL.

CS & CP AIBSNLOA in their address mentioned the lack of objectivity and vision in the existing SNEA leadership of the circle and emphasised on the need of AIGETOA and AIBSNLOA to come forward and fight for the development of BSNL, rather than for post and merge selfish issues. They also assured us all the help needed by the young brigade to March forward which they can provide by the experience they have being the core working members of SNEA for years.

Shri Dinesh Roy mentioned the need for a joint platform bringing all executive and non executive associations and unions together so that the burning issues like career progression and development works may be taken up with the management with more intensity.

After the initial addresses the Agenda Items were taken up.

E2 for new GE:

All the DS /DP were worried about the pay issues with the new GE recruited by BSNL after 2007. CP ensured that the matter has been taken up by the CHQ with the management in New Delhi and as such AIGETOA is demanding standard E2 pay scale for all GE from the very beginning, soon orders just to give temporary relief to new GE the proposal of fixing the pay @ pre revised 9850 are expected. The intermediate pay scales proposed by BSNL have already been rejected by the concerned ministries and now the management is left with no other option rather to implement standard pay scale as per other CPSU.

Gradation List of JTO:

The recent developments in New Delhi were brought to the notice of the house and the

fact that Kolkata CAT case regarding the same issue which is listed for the final hearing was also briefed up. It was decided to do all the needful to ensure the revision of the existing illegal gradation list published by some circles and implementation of revised DOPT guidelines for the same.

Pending R-8 Case / E1-E2 Training / Posting of GE:

Regarding these issues the house was intimated that the management is willing to ensure that GE are not wasted by posting them in useless areas like RSU etc , and any members left posted in these places will be taken up with the management so their talent can be utilised properly.

E1 to E2 left over cases were taken up with the management and the list of all 36 cases has been uploaded and the shortcoming like non availability of CR or SR for the eligible candidates is requested by GM (HR) to be taken up locally by the association so that this can be expedited.

LDCE for JTO to SDE:

Many DS were of the view that delaying in this LDCE is going to be a great loss specially to 2002 batch and it was necessary for the association to make sure that the hurdles are immediately removed and the LDCE is being held as soon as possible.

30% Superannuation benefits and EPF Issues:

The house was also updated about issues like 30% superannuation benefits, EPF issues and the house was updated about the developments taken place in New Delhi about these issues.

Circle Conference & Election of new Circle Body:

Discussion also took place regarding finalisation of date for circle conference. It was decided that the circle conference will be jointly organised by CTD and WBTC, in the third week of November.

FS Shri Amit Ranjan than took the financial aspects and submitted the annual accounts and some issues like reimbursement of donation of Rs 2000.00 for members who went to Delhi in operation sacrifice was accepted by the chair .

An organising committee was formed for organising this mega event which will be having participants from CTD, WBTC, ETR and ETP, Shri Prahald Basak was appointed to co-ordinate for north Bengal and Shri Bipin Kashyap will look after South Bengal. Shri Kshitij Mishra was appointed as the chief organiser for the mega circle conference.

A vote of thanks was given by Shri Manoj Kumar to all the participants and special thanks was given to the members of CMTS wing for holding the CEC beautifully and well

organised. Special thanks were given to Shri Mukesh Mahobia for wonderfully compeering the meet.
