Dear Sir,

Your kind is well aware about the hardship of Direct Recruits JTOs who are appointed and posted outside of their native circle and could not find the way out to get transferred even after working for more than 8 to 10 years. On persuasion of this association Corporate office recognizing their hardship issued several instructions to the circles to consider Rule-8 transfer request of JTOs after completion of 5 years of regular service as per the provision of BSNL transfer policy but unfortunately Circle management could not consider even after subsequent recruitment in JTO cadre in the pretext of shortage of JTO and being circle cadre.

Now, this is most convenient time to consider their request who are going to get promotion to SDE through this LDCE held on 4th March-2012. Moreover some of the executives likely to pass the LDCE are willing to work in hard tenure Circles/stations irrespective of their rank in LDCE.

It will be most appropriate to call and consider the request of candidates for intercircle transfer/ volunteers for the hard tenure stations before deciding the transfer
